Code of Conduct

At Longshaw Community Junior School we greatly value the strong relationship between parents or carers and all members of the school staff. Good communication, conducted in a positive and professional manner, is vital and helps our children to thrive. The following actions should be followed to ensure that parents and members of staff feel safe and valued:

At all times, communication and behaviour should be calm and respectful.

- Concerns and complaints should be expressed without the use of aggressive, obscene or intimidating language or tone. This applies to telephone conversations as well as face to face meetings.
- Members of staff should be welcoming, understanding and approachable at all times.
- All adults should behave in a manner which does not cause fear or intimidation to another person.

In cases where the above is not respected, visitors may be asked to leave the premises. The governors have the right to refuse entry to the school and its grounds if this is deemed appropriate.
