School will reopen on Monday, 5th January. We look forward to welcoming all our students back, ready for an exciting new term.

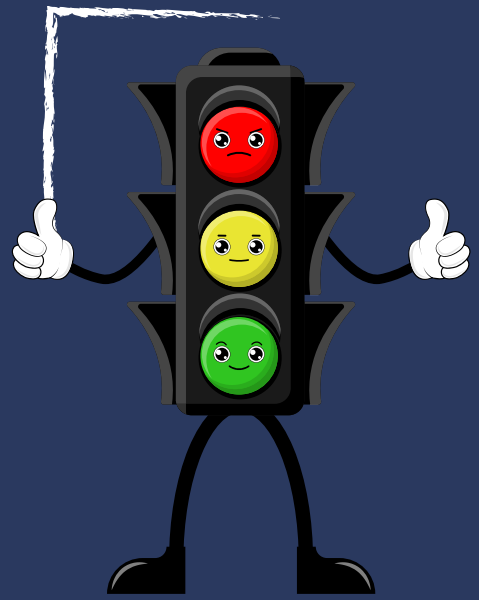
