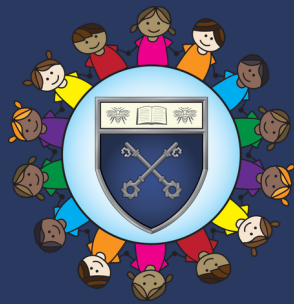

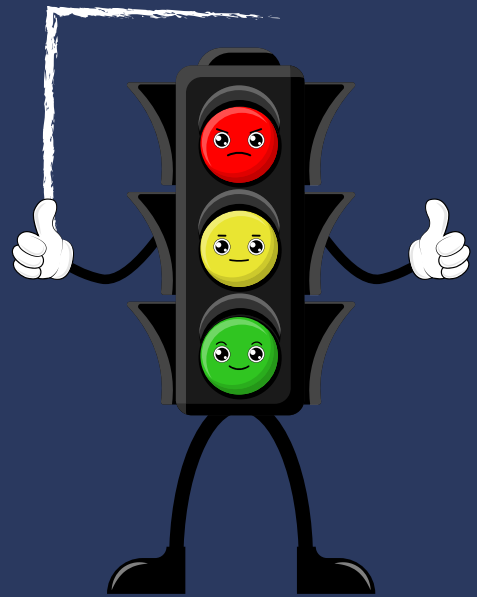
## Money Management in Year 5 & 6
