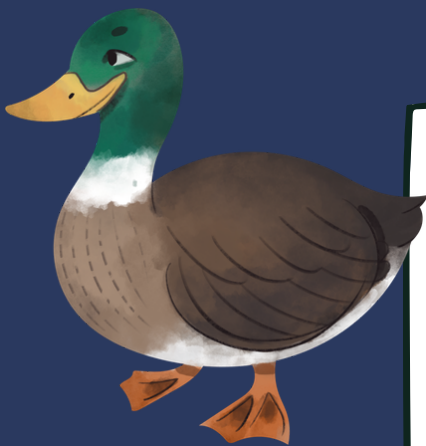


Year 2 First Visit Adventure

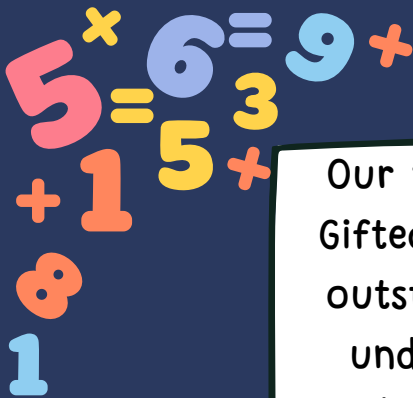

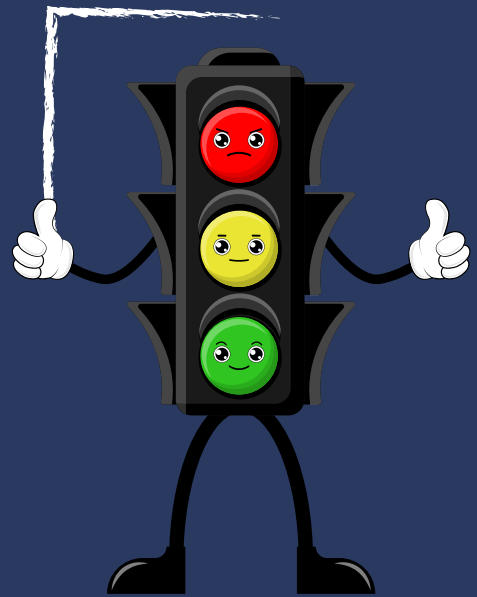
