Year 5 Trip to York

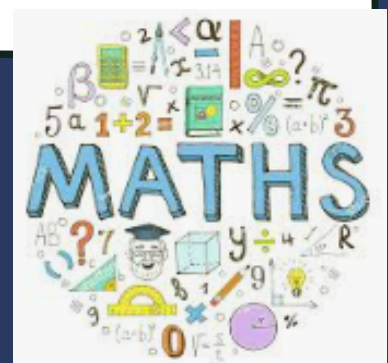

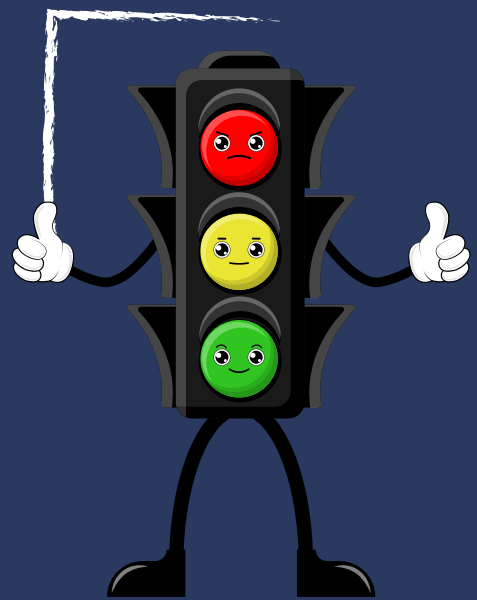
